Ask them to draw a glad monster face on the yellow circle and a sad monster face on the blue circle. Help them glue their monster faces back to back with a popsicle stick in the middle.

### Using Books to Support Social Emotional Development

The book introduces different monsters that are feeling glad, sad, mad, nervous, excited, etc. and contains bright, vibrant colors and fun shapes that kids (and adults) just love. After we discussed the monsters in the book (i.e., the shapes used to convey the monster's feelings, the colors used for each monster that expressed a feeling, etc ...
