The mental-models approach to risk communication (MMARC) highlights a five-step process, including developing the expert model, eliciting the public model and comparing it with the expert model, conducting confirmatory surveys among the broader population to determine the prevalence of the public model, drafting risk-communication messages based on the knowledge gap between experts and non-experts, and evaluating effectiveness of the messages (see Figure 2) [40,45].
